To acknowledge Bryan's commitment to the voluntary sector we have named this award in his memory. It is open to any volunteer fundraiser who, in the view of the nominator, has made a sustained and exceptional contribution to fundraising.

Fundraising Event or Campaign of the Year: Open to any fundraising event or campaign that, in the view of the nominator, demonstrated creativity and success in fundraising. Nominations could include events, direct mail campaigns, corporate relationships, or use of new media. The nomination can relate to any size or scale of event/campaign.
