We work in partnership with the Northern Ireland Ambulance Service (NIAS) to provide the Helicopter Emergency Medical Servce (HEMS) for N.I.



Our crew attend some of the most traumatic incidents across N.I. delivering the very best pre-hospital care to patients both at the scene & while transferring them to hospital.



On average, every single day at least one person in Northern Ireland finds themself in desperate need of Air Ambulance NI.



Air Ambulance NI is a charity. Each day fundraising of £5,500 needs to be raised to keep our service operational. We rely on support from the public and local businesses.

Pilots

- We have two pilots.
- Their names are Rich Steele and Dave O'Toole.
- Our pilots are highly skilled and can land almost anywhere! They regularly land in back gardens, school playgrounds and elevated helipads.

Paramedics

- We have eight HEMS paramedics.
- Our paramedics are part of the Northern Ireland Ambulance Service.
- Our paramedics undergo specialist technical crew member training.







- We have fifteen HEMS doctors.

- Every doctor in our crew, continues to work in their chosen hospital, alongside their shifts at the Helicopter Emergency Medical Service.




Colour in our EC135 Helicopter



• The diagonal lines also add up the totals to the right.




Temper Tantrums

Instructions


- Wash out and old jam jar (any jar or tub will do!)

- All of your 50p's will go towards keeping our helicopter in the air!












