

1.WHAT IS THE FIRST STEP PROGRAMME?

The First Step is a tailored training programme to empower women to recognise the positive difference they can make to civic and public life. The programme will give the opportunity to 100 women living in Northern Ireland to increase their sense of self-worth, develop their leadership skills, learn how to work together to effect real and long-lasting change and to rise above and beyond their barriers and their backgrounds.

The First Step programme is the Groundwork NI approach to support women to increase their networks and gain a better understanding of the local landscape and how their skills can help them empower themselves and their communities.

2.WHAT TO EXPECT?

The First Step programme will provide all participants with tailored training and mentoring as well as networking opportunities. Our aim is to help you develop your leadership skills and networks and to enable collaboration amongst women of diverse backgrounds. The First Step programme consists of 12 sessions in total which will be delivered online via Zoom, as well as a Graduation Ceremony that we hope we will be able to host in person.

The sessions will be delivered by our experienced facilitators and many high-profile keynote speakers.

On your second learning day, you will have the opportunity to meet our 10 mentors. The mentor who will be assigned to your group will guide you through your learning experience for the rest of the programme.

The programme will be coordinated and monitored by the Groundwork NI Project Manager, who will be your first point of contact.

5.HOW TO APPLY?

6. PROGRAMME OUTLINE

The First Step programme will be conducted **online**. We do this to keep you safe from Covid and to ensure that no disruptions will occur due to possible changes in Covid regulations. The platform we will be using to hold the sessions is **Zoom**.

All sessions will be held in the **evening**. All learning and mentoring sessions will start at 7 pm and finish at 8.45 pm with a 10-minute comfort break. The Welcome Event and the Closing Event will both start at 7 pm and finish at 9 pm, again with a 10-minute comfort break.

At the end of the First Step programme, we are planning to hold a Graduation Event. Our proposing date, as you can see below, is the 16th of December. Our intention is to hold an in-person half-day event that will allow mentors, mentees, and other stakeholders to get to know each other better and to celebrate your achievements together.

However, with the Covid restrictions changing regularly, we are not in a position to confirm anything yet.

Attendance at the Graduation Event is not mandatory, and more information will follow later.
