Objectives of Service

Family Connections works with children and families towards the following outcomes:-

- Children and parents will improve their sense of well-being
- Children will be better prepared for school and will achieve in school
- Parents will be more confident in their role as parents and as educators
- Parents and children will increase their participation in school and community life

We work with families through children's play sessions, family support, parenting programmes, family learning and parent and child sessions.

Initial Specific Responsibilities

This post will be responsible to:-

- plan and deliver programmes of play and learning activities to improve outcomes for children
- build parental capacity, supporting parents respectfully to engage them in their child's learning and development through home visits and parent and child sessions.
- deliver parent sessions and parenting programmes to parents, for parents of preschool and primary age children
- work as part of a team to support positive parenting build linkages with schools, community organisations and family support services

The post holder will be required to adapt to the needs of parents using a range of approaches - online, telephone and outdoor meet ups as well as face to face support.
