The role will involve the provision of expert physiotherapy interventions, advice and support to patients and their families/ carers in the community and in hospice hubs.

Applicants must have a degree in physiotherapy or equivalent and be registered with the Health Care Professions Council, and be a member of The Chartered Society for Physiotherapy. A minimum of five years' post graduate experience including two years' as a Clinical Specialist is required, as well as experience in one of the following areas inpatient, rehab or community post - orthopaedics, respiratory, oncology, musculoskeletal, neurology lymphoedema or palliative care.
