Essential Criteria

- A minimum Level 3 qualification in Hairdressing.
- A minimum of 3 years' recent experience in the Hairdressing Industry.

Desirable Criteria

- Previous experience of training and assessing Hairdressing in a Further Education and/or Training Organisation.
- A recognised qualification in Teaching.
- Experience of teaching Hairdressing qualifications up to Level 3.
- Experience of teaching Barbering qualifications up to Level 3.
- Assessor's Award.
- Current driving license and access to own vehicle.

Applicants for this post must have good organisational, administrative and communication skills, with an adaptable personality and an understanding of the needs and problems facing young people from marginalised backgrounds.
